**10 NIGHT MALARIA FREE SAFARI
PILANESBERG, MADIKWE AND CAPE TOWN**



31ST JULY

Depart UK on direct flight to OR Tambo International Airport where you will arrive early the next morning.

1ST AUGUST

On arrival you are met at the airport by your driver and transferred on a private basis to Black Rhino Lodge in the Pilanesberg National Park for 3 nights. The journey is approximately 3 ½ hours. **Included: Three meals per day, two game drives per day and 3 x Conservation Levy**

Pilanesberg's natural eco-system exists in a transition zone of the dry Kalahari and the wetter Lowveld. Therefore unlike any other national game park the Pilanesberg hosts a combination of animal, bird, insect, reptilian and vegetation species. Species such as the Brown Hyena, Springbok, Red Eyed Bulbul and Camel Thorn tree, normally found in dry areas co-habitat with Impala, Black Eyed Bulbul and the Cape Chestnut trees, normally found in wetter areas. A major advantage of the Pilanesberg is that it is malaria free, which is not the case with other game parks further north.

Black Rhino Private Game Reserve is incorporated in the western side of Pilanesberg National Park. The landscape is a combination of rolling hills, tumbled mountains, valleys, grassland plains and tamboti forests.

Game sightings include a variety of predators such as lion, leopard and cheetah. Herds of elephant and buffalo are often seen at close range. Antelope such as sable, kudu and eland roam the bush freely and are not shy. The game and bird viewing opportunities are truly incredible.



Black Rhino Game Lodge is set amongst the trees of an old tamboti forest at the foot of an ancient volcanic crater that today comprises one of South Africa's most exciting Big 5 eco-tourism destinations - the greater Pilanesberg National Park. It is from here, accompanied by your personal game ranger, that you will be able to explore a 58,000ha wildlife sanctuary and discover the magic of the African bush.

The lodge is built between a tamboti forest overlooking a busy waterhole which is a hive of bird and animal activity and a magnet for the elephant. On many occasions the stillness of the night is broken by the roaring of lions and the franklins sing the morning wake up call.

Once you are awakened with a hot cup of coffee your ranger will take you out on an exceptional game drive taking you through Black Rhino Reserve into the unexplored valley of the Pilanesberg until you reach the 200km network Pilanesberg Park roads.



4TH AUGUST

After breakfast you will be met at Black Rhino Game Lodge and enjoy a private transfer to Jaci's Safari Lodges in Madikwe National Park for 3 nights. **Included: All Meals, tea/coffees, game drives/walks**

Set in the magnificent Madikwe Game Reserve in South Africa's North-West Province Jaci's Lodges offers you outstanding game-viewing and a choice of luxurious accommodation options and safari activities.

Jaci's Tree Lodge features eight luxury Treehouse Suites built on wooden stilts and connected by raised walkways. Tree Lodge guests can also enjoy the submerged Terrapin Hide – a favourite of amateur and photographic professionals, Naledi Treehouse – boasting a KolKol hot tub and unbeatable views of the active waterhole, and newly completed Tlou Deck – the best sundowner spot at the lodge which highlights the golden hour beauty that Madikwe is famous for.





The safari-style accommodation at Jaci's Safari Lodge features six luxury Tented Suites and two private family friendly Suites all reflecting striking, colourful decor and South African atmosphere.

The lodges' two Starbed Suites are set over two levels offering the option of sleeping out under a canopy of stars. Bursts of colour, safari decor touches, bold furniture pieces and luxurious finishes reflect sophistication with a bushveld twist.

7TH AUGUST

Today you will be met at the lodge for your private transfer to OR Tambo International Airport. On arrival you will make your way to the domestic terminal for your flight to Cape Town.



On arrival into Cape Town you will be met and transferred on a private basis to the family friendly Mount Nelson Hotel for 4 nights on a bed and breakfast basis. Set in the heart of Cape Town, the Mount Nelson is centrally located and is very close to the Red Bus stop allowing you to explore the city at your own pace and escape back to the hotel for a rest or a cooling swim. Alternatively you can hire a car for your stay in Cape Town and explore further afield – please ask!



The hotel has been welcoming children of all ages for many years and offers a quiet oasis with expansive lawned gardens and a fabulous, heated swimming pool. The hotel has a selection of beautiful individually designed rooms and suites to choose from and families feel at home in the spacious light-filled suites or interconnecting rooms.

Facilities for families include cots and rollout beds for families with babies and young children, a laundry service for children's clothing, a children's room service menu, milk and cookies at turndown, a selection of books and DVD's available at front office and babysitting service on request.

Additionally, there is tennis, a children's club which is a supervised entertainment area offering games, books, a computer, free internet access, DVDs, PlayStations, and Xboxes or relax with a family spa treatment tailored for families with children. At the end of your stay you are transferred back to OR Tambo International Airport for your international flight home.
