



10 Night Elsa's Safari - A Luxury Kenya Flying Safari



A wonderful safari visiting at the Iconic Giraffe Manor in Nairobi, Elsa's Kopje in Meru National Park, and Elephant Pepper camp in the Mara North Conservancy. Superb lodges, wonderful guides and flying in between camps!

Day 1 Nairobi – Giraffe Manor

On arrival into Jomo Kenyatta International Airport Tracks Safari's representative will meet you and transfer you to Giraffe Manor for one night on a bed and breakfast basis.

Giraffe Manor an exclusive boutique hotel, set in 12 acres of private land within 140 acres of indigenous forest in the Langata suburb of Nairobi. As one of Nairobi's most iconic buildings, Giraffe Manor has extraordinary appeal, that harks back to the 1930s when European visitors first flocked to East Africa to enjoy safaris. With its stately façade, elegant interior, verdant green gardens, sunny terraces and delightful courtyards, guests often remark that it's like walking into the film Out of Africa: indeed, one of its twelve rooms is named after the author Karen Blixen.

However, the most fascinating thing about Giraffe Manor is its herd of resident Rothschild's giraffe who may visit morning and evening, sometimes poking their long necks into the windows in the hope of a treat, before retreating to their forest sanctuary.



Day Two

Meru National Park, Elsa's Kopje

Today you will be transferred to Wilson Airport in time to check in for your scheduled flight to Meru. On arrival you will be met at the airstrip and transferred to Elsa's Kopje.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis

Romantic and beautifully styled, Elsa's Kopje is sculpted into Mughwango Hill above the site of George Adamson's original camp where he raised and released orphan lions, long before conservation became fashionable. Each cottage is crafted around the rocks, with a large bedroom, open sitting room, veranda and spacious bathroom, each with breathtaking views.

Guests can enjoy inimitable seclusion in the vast expanse of Elsa's Kopje, boasting 870km², the equivalent of 215,000 acres, of authentic African landscape. The park offers a thriving rhino sanctuary, and is famous for large elephant herds, hippo, lion, and birdlife; Meru National Park is recognised as having more diversity of animal species than any other park in East Africa.

The Elsa's Kopje guides have the whole park to themselves and know the park intimately. All the guides are Bronze or Silver level Kenya Professional Safari Guides Association certified. The National Park is one of the most beautiful in Africa, and apart from being home to plentiful lion, cheetah, leopard, elephant and rhino, it is known for its diversity of habitat and wildlife, including the rare and beautiful lesser Kudu. A birders paradise, Meru boasts over 400 species, as well surprising botanical treasures including the giant baobab tree and rare paper bark Albitzia.



Days Five

Loisaba Tented Camp, Loisaba Conservancy, Laikipia

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Loisaba Airstrip. On arrival you will be met and transferred to Loisaba Tented Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis



Perched on the edge of an escarpment, Loisaba Tented Camp is designed to capitalize on unhindered views across Laikipia's mottled landscape all the way to Mt Kenya. All accommodations and main areas enjoy a breathtaking vantage point over an expansive panorama.

Spacious and airy tents are custom-built with large floor-to-ceiling doors and windows, high ceilings and polished wood floors. The tent suites are adorned in chic Africana furniture with a modern European twist. The main areas of Loisaba Tented Camp include a large open dining area, separate open lounge and bar, a large wooden decking area for outside dining, relaxing and enjoying the view, and one of Africa's most picturesque infinity pools.

Home to elephant, a healthy population of lion, the rare wild dog and an abundance of other species, Loisaba is a prime example of successful collaboration between conservation, communities, ranching and tourism. Activities include game driving both day and night, horse-riding, camel-trekking, guided bush walks, fishing, mountain biking, cultural visits to Samburu villages and visits to the anti-poaching sniffer dogs.

Day Eight

Masai Mara, Elephant Pepper Camp

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip in time to board your scheduled flight to the Masai Mara. You will be met at Mara Shikar Airstrip and transferred to Elephant Pepper Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis



Located in the Mara North Conservancy, the heart of the Masai Mara ecosystem, Elephant Pepper Camp is the perfect base from which to explore the Mara.

The vast, fertile plains of the Maasai Mara boasts a plethora of wildlife; with over 450 bird species and both resident and transient populations of lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant, giraffe, to name a few, the plains are dense with game. Elephant Pepper Camp is perfect for those wanting to observe the spectacle of the migration. The camp's remote location allows the stars to shine bright at night.

The Elephant Pepper Camp guides are Bronze or Silver level Kenya Professional Safari Guides Association certified. Mara North Conservancy is a privately managed conservancy in the core of the Masai Mara and game driving in Mara North Conservancy is restricted to vehicles belonging to lodges within the conservancy - so Elephant Pepper guests have this outstanding part of the Masai Mara almost to themselves.

Day Eleven

After a last game drive in the Masai Mara you are transferred back to the airstrip for your scheduled flight back to Nairobi Wilson Airport. On arrival our representative will meet and transfer you to the international airport for your journey home.
