DAY ONE

Arrive into Lusaka International Airport where you are met and transferred to Pioneer Camp for one night on a dinner bed and breakfast basis.

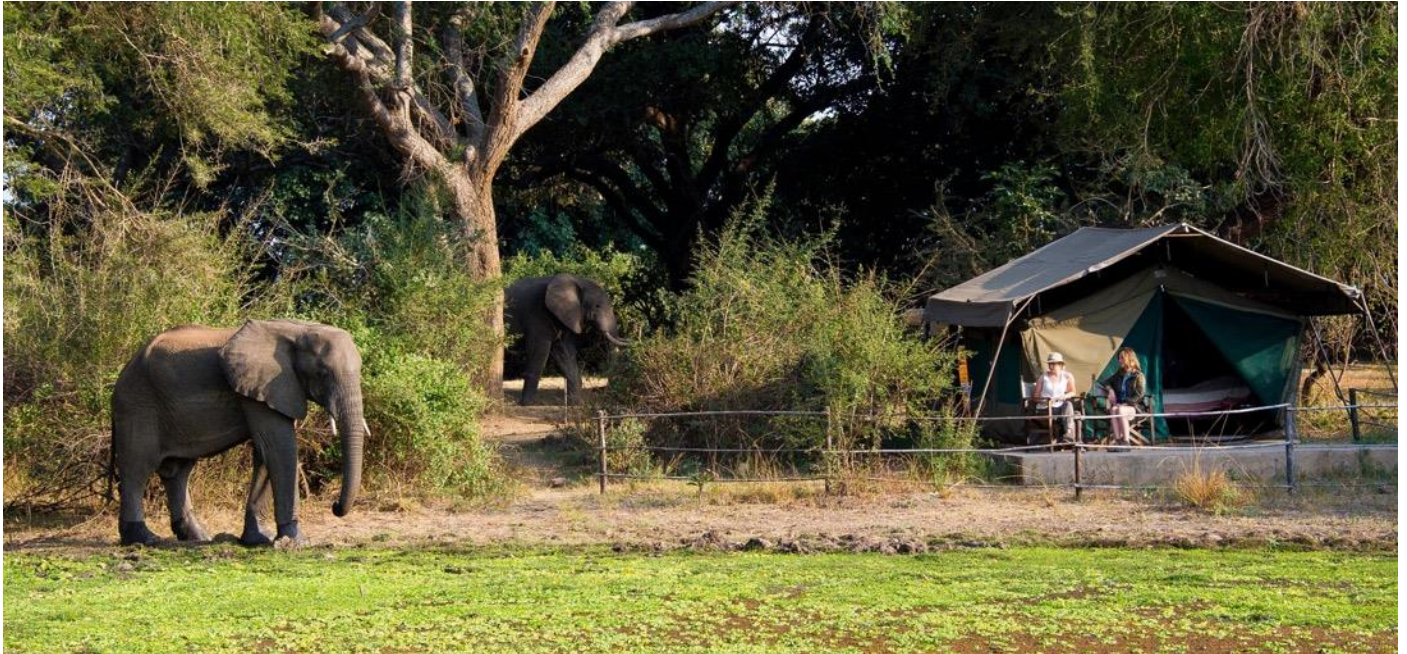
Pioneer Camp is an ideal place to stay if you need to be near Lusaka but don't want to be in it! Only 14 kms (30 minutes) from the International Airport, the lodge offers a restful stop over before your Zambian safari and has a range of chalets, a bar and restaurant.

DAY TWO

Today you will transfer back to Lusaka International Airport in time to check in for your flight to Mfuwe Airport. On arrival you will be met by Flatdogs Camp and transferred by road and game drive to Flatdogs Camp for 3 nights on a full board basis including safari activities (drinks are extra).

The Luangwa Valley is home to an astonishing diversity of life, including around 100 species of mammals, more than 400 bird species and over 2000 types of plant. Added to this, there's an amazing density of game, particularly along the riverine strip where wildlife congregate to drink especially in the dry season.

Flatdogs offers a range of accommodation to suit all kinds of varied budgets – there are cool and spacious Chalet rooms, the wild and very unique Jackalberry Treehouse, the airy Safari Tents with 270° views and the top level Crocodile Nest. There is a swimming pool, WiFi in the main area, a book swap, and curio shop supporting local artists and artisans.



DAY FIVE

Today you will transfer deeper into the South Luangwa National Park to Nkonzi Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Deep in the heart of South Luangwa National Park Nkonzi Camp is a unique tented camp offering an outstanding safari experience. Nkonzi is small and intimate with just 4 safari tents and prides itself on offering every guest personalised attention.



Each walk-in safari tent has an open-air ensuite bathroom with hot water bucket showers and flushing loo. Inside are wooden-framed beds with crisp cotton linen, solar powered lights, a small charging station and a fan. At the centre of camp stands the atmospheric Swahili Meru tent - home to comfy sofas, our candle-lit dining area and a small bush-bar, this is the perfect place to relax and soak in the safari experience.

Meals are created on site by our wonderful team in the bush kitchen and the camp is proud to use locally grown, fresh produce wherever it can.



DAY EIGHT

Today you will be transferred to Luambe Camp in the remote Luambe National Park for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Accommodation at Luambe Camp is in en-suite safari tents all of which enjoy a spectacular location beneath the trees on the banks of the Luangwa River. Guests will be accommodated in 4 spacious en-suite safari tents, each offering a spectacular view of the Luangwa River and its abundant wildlife.

The camp offers a fully-inclusive package which includes all meals, local drinks, laundry and activities such as game drives, bush walks, guided birding tours and village tours to Chitungulu.

The grasslands of the Chipuka Plains are favoured by buffalo, elephant and other species such as impala, puku, kudu, Crawshay's zebra and the Thornicroft's giraffe. Visitors could also be lucky enough to spot reedbuck, Cookson's wildebeest, eland, wild dog, leopard, hyena and lion.



DAY ELEVEN

After spending 9 nights in the South Luangwa and Luambe National Parks you will fly on to Livingstone for 3 nights at Chundukwa River Lodge on an all-inclusive basis.



Chundukwa River Lodge is situated in Zambia along the banks of the Zambezi River, 25km from the historic town of Livingstone and the Victoria Falls. This ideal location means that you're close enough to head into town to see the Falls or pursue some of the town-based activities but far enough to enjoy the peace and tranquillity of the Zambezi River.

The lodge has 5 river-front chalets and a 3-bedroomed cottage - all with spectacular views over the Zambezi River. The 5 chalets and family house are individually decorated and designed but all focus on their unique open-fronted layout offering breath taking views over the Zambezi River. They are designed to sit quietly and comfortably within the natural surroundings and the decor and furniture has been tastefully

made using recycled wood, metal and sustainable reeds. Everything is made locally by local tradesmen and women from the local village.

DAY FOURTEEN

Today you will transfer back to Livingstone International Airport in time to check in for your international flight home.

This itinerary can be extended to visit Zimbabwe or Botswana or you can add the Kafue National Park at the beginning of your safari – please ask!
