



TUMAREN TO OL TOME CAMP - LAIKIPIA - 4 nights

This safari is good for those wanting a walking safari experience with the luxury of home comforts rather than mobile camping. This trip is rich in wildlife while our Samburu and Masai guides provide a great perspective on the local cultures of Northern Kenya.


The safari is exclusive to your group and your guide will plan the days according to your desires, wildlife and the local calendar. Each day can include guided walks, camel rides, gamedrives, birdwatching, picnics, tracking, visiting a local manyatta or market (if the day is right), visiting a school, rock climbing (on request), and rafting in the river. The same guide and team look after your throughout the safari and both Tumaren and OI Tome are hosted by your Karisia team.



Day 1 & 2: TUMAREN CAMP - 2 nights

Set on the edge of a wide plain this beautiful camp looks west to Losera Moru and Mukenya, granitic inselbergs that define our local landscape. Each tent is furnished

uniquely and all the tents offer sweeping verandas from which most of our plains game can be spotted. The grasslands are rich with wildlife and you can spend hours watching animals wander by or photographing the huge variety of birds coming to the bird bath.









Day 3 & 4: OL TOME CAMP - 2 nights

You will wake up early and after a delectable breakfast, set off on a walk looking for wildlife and their tracks. The camels will accompany you and can be ridden at any time but also they will help carry extra lenses or clothing as well as your water and en-route bitings. On the way you might climb Losera Moru, a spectacular rock with views to Mount Kenya. If you are lucky you might spot a Striped Hyena, a Klipspringers or the Wilddogs that have denned there for the past few years. You will arrive at OI Tome in time for an ice cold drink and a tasty lunch.

This spacious camp sits high on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro river and the wooden deck is perfect for watching elephants wander by or playing in the river. The tents are kept cool with thatch roofs and each tent has its own big verandah with ensuite bathroom.

Like at Tumaren, from OI Tome Camp you will embark on morning or evening walks exploring rocks, river and plains. The mix of birds and game is slightly different here beside the river and your guide will point out some of the subtle differences in habitat.
