

7 NIGHTS FAMILY FRIENDLY SAFARI AND BEACH MALARIA FREE – SOUTH AFRICA



Overnight flight from the UK to Johannesburg. On arrival clear customs, pick up your luggage and make your way to the domestic departures to check in for your flight to Port Elizabeth.

DAY ONE

On arrival into Port Elizabeth, you are met and transferred on a private basis to Lalibela Marks Camp for 4 nights on an all-inclusive basis.




Lalibela is a conservation project that currently consists of 10,500 hectares and is home to the Big 5 - lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo & leopard - as well as other predators like cheetah, hyena, jackal & lynx. The reserve has vast areas Savannah Grassland - the biome that has by far the highest carrying capacity — able to sustain truly vast herds of plains game like zebra, impala, wildebeest, red hartebeest, blesbuck and eland. This, in turn, allows a remarkable density of free-roaming lions.

The primary focus at Lalibela is the conservation of indigenous flora and fauna, taking into account the community in the area. This is achieved by a huge team of diverse and special people – all who share the vision of long-term sustainability in a fast-changing world.



Mark's Camp is a family-friendly lodge which has 8 stone and thatch chalets decorated in a relaxed Pan-African style, each comfortably furnished chalet has an ensuite bathroom, air-conditioning and ceiling-fans for those warm summer nights. All of the chalets open up onto your own private viewing deck.

One of the appealing features of Mark's Camp is the abundance of birdlife which can be viewed from the rooms, pool deck – there are two swimming pools - or central lounge area. There is a large waterhole in front of the camp and you can sit and watch antelope, giraffe, elephant and predators coming to the waterhole to drink. The camp has an outdoor dining 'boma' for fireside dinners and open-air brunches as well as a lovely, indoor dining area.




DAY FIVE


Today you will be met at Mark's Camp and transferred on a private basis to Robberg Beach Lodge for 3 nights on a bed and breakfast basis in a family room. Facilities include two outdoor pools, two lounges, two honesty bars, a rooftop viewing deck, 24-hr reception and check-in.

With all the luxuries of a hotel the Family Room has a generous open-plan living area perfect for family holidays and is a stone's throw from Robberg 5 Blue Flag Beach. This room is child friendly with a king-size bed and a queen-size sofa bed that can comfortably accommodate 2 children up to the age of 11 sharing with adults.

The main bedroom is separate to the living area and has an ensuite bathroom that includes heated-towel rails and an open plan shower and bath with a separate toilet. The bathroom is also equipped with amenities, fresh fluffy towels and robes. The Family Room includes heating/cooling air-conditioning and a flat-screen TV with selected cable channels. The open plan kitchenette comprises of the necessities, including an oven, stove, microwave, kettle, toaster and a small fridge for your convenience.



The room is serviced daily and breakfast is included in the room rate.
