


KENYA FAMILY SAFARI 9 NIGHT FLYING SAFARI

Tortilis Camp - Amboseli Lewa Safari Camp - Lewa Wildlife Conservancy Elephant Pepper Camp - Masai Mara Conservancy



Day 1- Amboseli National Park, Tortilis Camp

On arrival into Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you will be met by Tracks Safari's representative and transferred to Wilson Airport for your flight to Amboseli. On arrival you will be collected from the airstrip and taken to Tortilis Camp where you will be greeted by the beauty of Africa's largest mountain, Mount Kilimanjaro.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.



Amboseli is best known for its unrivalled views of Kilimanjaro, and its large elephant population. Tortilis Camp is named after the flat-topped, umbrella thorn tree, the Acacia Tortilis, and is situated in one of Amboseli's areas of Acacia Tortilis woodland, with the majestic backdrop of Africa's highest mountain, and the World's highest free-standing mountain, snow-capped Kilimanjaro.

Game drives, walks, sundowners and bush meals take place both inside the Park, and within the camp's private 30,000 acre game concession. Tortilis Camp's tents are all large and spacious, with elegant en suite bathrooms. There is a main lounge, bar and dining area, all exquisitely built with natural materials and thatched roofs, with magnificent views of Kilimanjaro.

Day 4 – Lewa Wilderness Conservancy, Lewa Safari Camp

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip in time for your scheduled flight to Wilson where you will connect with the scheduled flight to Lewa. On arrival you will be met by a representative from Lewa Safari Camp who will transfer you to the camp.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.



Lewa Safari Camp has a stunning location within Lewa Wildlife Conservancy, with outstanding game viewing and spectacular views of Mt. Kenya. The camp has exquisite gardens with a large sunny veranda and swimming pool to enjoy during the day, and cosy log fires for more chilly evenings.

Lewa Wildlife Conservancy is home to about 10% Kenya's black rhino population and the largest population of Grevy's zebra in the world. Lewa re-invests all the profits generated from tourism (including profits from Lewa Safari Camp) into its core programmes. By visiting Lewa, you help thousands of people from different cultures improve their lives, and give their children a future, at the same time as ensuring Africa's wildlife has a stable home.

Day 7 - Masai Mara, Elephant Pepper Camp

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airstrip in time for your scheduled flight to Wilson where you will connect with the scheduled flight to the Masai Mara. On arrival you will be met by a representative from Elephant Pepper Camp who will transfer you to the camp with game viewing en route.

Accommodation is booked for 3 nights on a full board basis.



Elephant Pepper Camp is a small and exclusive safari camp, situated in the heart of the Masai Mara's protected Mara North Conservancy. The camp looks out across the Mara's vast open savannah plains and the spacious canvas tents are comfortably furnished, featuring solar lighting, and en suite bathrooms with flush toilets and traditional safari showers. Elephant Pepper Camp brings people back to nature – no traffic, no permanent structures, just the sights and sounds of the African bush.

Day 10 - Depart

After a last game drive in the Masai Mara you will be transferred to the airstrip in time for your flight back to Nairobi Wilson Airport. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your Nairobi hotel or to the international airport for your journey home.

This safari can be extended to include time on safari or perhaps time at the beach on the Kenyan Coast or the islands of Zanzibar, Mafia or Pemba in Tanzania – please ask!
