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Kenya Safari and Rhino Tracking Experience A 9 night conservation Safari



Day One: Saruni Samburu

On arrival into Nairobi International Airport you are met and transferred to Wilson Airport for your flight to Samburu. On arrival you are met and transferred to Saruni Samburu for 3 nights.

Saruni Samburu is located at the heart of the Kalama Community Wildlife Conservancy, about 7 km from the Northern border of the Samburu National Reserve (accessed through the Kalama Gate). It also borders

Ngutuk Ongiron to the west, Namunyak Community Conservation Trust to the north and Sera Community Wildlife Conservation to the north east.

Centered around a core conservation area of 3,150 hectares, Kalama represents a crucial migratory corridor between northern and southern conservation areas of this spectacular region of Kenya. Large herds of elephants cross Kalama in their migratory routes between the different conservancies.

Saruni Samburu's six luxury, eco-chic villas are open and spacious with spectacular views over Kalama Conservancy and Mount Kenya. As the only lodge in over 200,000 acres of unspoiled wilderness teeming with wildlife and guided by Samburu warriors passionate about their land and culture, the safari experience at Saruni Samburu is intimate and truly exceptional.



Day Four: Saruni Rhino

This morning depart Saruni Samburu accompanied by Samburu guides for Sera Conservancy and Saruni Rhino for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis. Located amidst swaying doum palms along a sandy 'lugga' dry river bed. Enjoy lunch in camp with breath-taking views of a waterhole frequently visited by wildlife.



Saruni Rhino is located in 350,000 hectares-large Sera Conservancy in the wild, undiscovered northern frontier of Kenya. This unique lodge is a little over 1.5 hours' drive from Saruni Samburu lodge in nearby Kalama Conservancy. Saruni Rhino offers the first rhino tracking experience in East Africa: an amazing walking safari that provides a uniquely thrilling adventure, but also allows our guests to actively contribute

to the protection of this iconic species. Herds of elephants populate this vast landscape, offering also amazing birdwatching and cultural experiences with the “singing wells”.

Saruni Rhino offers a unique and exhilarating adventure whilst also allowing guests to actively contribute to the protection of this iconic species. You will track black rhino on foot, accompanied by an expert Saruni guide and a highly-trained Sera Community Conservancy ranger, equipped with a transmitter correlating to the GPS whereabouts of the 12 rhino throughout the 54, 000 hectares-large sanctuary.

You will have the opportunity to visit the singing wells of Samburu. Home to The Fifty Wells Kisima Hamsini is a series of fifty springs where local pastoralists take their livestock to water, digging deep in the barren land filling up wells to in-turn fill up holders and troughs whilst singing a unique melody to which each Moran’s herd individually heeds.



Day Seven: Saruni Mara / Saruni Wild

Following breakfast in camp leave early morning from Saruni Rhino for your departing onward flight to the Mara, arriving in the Masai Mara an hour and a half after take-off. On arrival you will be met and transferred to Saruni Wild for a 3 night stay.

Saruni Wild is a tented camp elegantly and comfortably furnished with all the necessary luxuries of a wild yet classic safari. The camp is located in the heart of the Masai Mara plains on the border between Lemek Conservancy and Mara North Conservancy. Surrounded by tens of thousands acres of pristine, untouched wilderness, the camp has an outstanding setting and you can watch wildlife from your tent. Enjoy endless views, fire-lit meals under the vast African sky and guided game drives led by Maasai warriors.

The Masai Mara ecosystem has an astounding variety of wildlife and is the most wildlife populous ecosystem on Earth. The area has amazing birdlife with over 550 species and its herds of plains game are second to none. The forests and the plains provide a fascinating diversity of plants, trees and flowers.



Day Ten

Today you will transfer to the airstrip in time to board your flight back to Wilson Airport. On arrival you will be met and transferred to Nairobi International Airport for your international flight back home.

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
