




Day One

On arrival into Nairobi International Airport you are met by Tracks Safari's representatives and transferred to Wilson Airport for your scheduled flight to Lewa Safari Camp. On arrival you are met and transferred to camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.


Lewa Safari Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis



The conservancy covers 65,000 acres, a vast wilderness. Lewa has dramatic views to the south of snow-capped Mt. Kenya, and to the north down to the arid lands of Tassia and II Ngwesi. It has many diverse habitats from pristine forest, fertile grasslands, extensive springs and acacia woodland.

Registered as a rhino conservancy in 1983, the conservancy is famous for its successful rhino and Grevy zebra breeding, two endangered species; Lewa is home to 10% of Kenya's rhino, and 20% of the world's population of Grevy zebra. The whole conservancy is fenced, and the conservancy employs over 150 rangers. The conservancy does extensive outreach work into the surrounding communities with its Community Development Program, including healthcare, education, micro-finance, and water projects – in order to share with the community the benefits of wildlife. With over 70 recorded mammal species within the conservancy, for guests, the wildlife experience is unrivalled.

Featuring large tented bedrooms with verandas and full ensuite bathrooms, Lewa Safari camp offers authentic comfort for its visitors; cosy log fires in the sitting room are perfect for relaxing after a day in the Conservancy. This unique and exclusive retreat offers privileged access to 65,000 acres of private protected wilderness.



DAY FOUR

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Mara. On arrival you are met by Elephant Pepper Camp and transferred to the camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Elephant Pepper for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis

Located in the Mara North Conservancy, the heart of the Masai Mara ecosystem, Elephant Pepper Camp is the perfect base from which to explore the wonders of the Mara.

The vast, fertile plains of the Masai Mara boasts a plethora of wildlife; with over 450 bird species and both resident and transient populations of lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant, giraffe, to name a few, the plains are dense with game. Elephant Pepper Camp is perfect for those wanting to observe the spectacle of the migration, classified among the "Seven Wonders of the World", when, from July to November, over 1.3 million wildebeest and zebra cross from the Serengeti in search of greener pastures.

The camp's remote location allows the stars to shine bright at night, undimmed by harsh lighting; guests enjoy the unique experience of listening to the sounds of lion, leopard and hyena foraging and hunting, whilst being cosseted with traditional and modern comforts such as a campfire and cosy duvets.



Upon waking, tea and freshly-baked biscuits ease guests into a morning of game drives or bush walks across the conservancy in the company of highly experienced local guides and wildlife rangers. Blankets warm the guests on night game drives back to camp after sundowners in the bush. Delicious Northern Italian cuisine, fresh baking and sensational salads complete the rustic luxury sensation.



DAY SEVEN

Today you will be transferred back to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Ukunda on the Kenyan coast. On arrival you will be met and transferred to Kinondo Kwetu for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Kinondo Kwetu is situated far end of the remote Galu Beach, south of Diani beach. The nearest hotel is 2 km away and therefore the beach is very private. Lay down on a sun bed and admire the vast ocean or grab one of the foldable beach chairs and sit with your feet in the incoming tide.

Kinondo Kwetu is an African "Home away from Home" - a place where you really can you "feel" where you are. Where nature and scenery are an adventure in itself. A place that winds you down where you are completely content in doing nothing at all – but with the option to do a lot if you want.
