


10 NIGHT KRUGER, SABI SAND AND CAPE TOWN




Depart London Heathrow with BA or Virgin non-stop flight to Johannesburg arriving early the next morning.

DAY ONE

On arrival into OR Tambo International Airport pass through passport control, pick up your luggage and make your way to the Federal Air departure lounge for your scheduled flight to MalaMala private airstrip.

On arrival at MalaMala Private Airstrip you will be met by a MalaMala vehicle and transferred the short distance to MalaMala Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.



MalaMala Game Reserve is one of the largest private Big Five game reserves in South Africa and is worldrenowned for offering some of the finest game viewing in South Africa. Comprising 13200 ha MalaMala shares a 19 km unfenced boundary with the world-famous Kruger National Park and lies strategically sandwiched between the Kruger National Park and the Sabi Sand Reserve.



MalaMala has 20 kms of Sand River frontage - this perennial river acts as a magnet for animals in this pristine wildlife area and is the foundation of MalaMala's unrivalled game viewing and wildlife experience.

Activities include game drives and safari walks and wildlife you might see at MalaMala include the big five, cheetah and wild dog. Preserving and protecting the environmental integrity of this special piece of Africa has always been at the core of MalaMala's existence.

MalaMala Camp is a haven of understated luxury combining warm comfort and superb service with unrivalled views of the Sand River and surrounding bush. It is truly a place of legends where rare photographs, old maps and extraordinary mementos rub shoulders with the works of renowned contemporary wildlife artists. The camp is an unfenced oasis in the middle of the bush.

DAY FOUR

Today you will be transferred on a private basis to Savanna Lodge in the Sabi Sand Reserve for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.




Savanna Lodge is an exclusive 5-star lodge situated in the Sabi Sand Reserve within the greater Kruger National Park Conservancy. The lodge lies in an area where Big 5 sightings are frequent - it is not unusual to see lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, and rhino in a single game drive. Numerous nearby dams and a series of waterholes in front of the lodge attract many species, especially in the dry winter months when elephants are daily visitors.

The lodge offers nine suites - seven suites have tented roofs – and each suite offers private patios, plunge pools and outdoor showers as well as air-conditioned interiors, minibars and a coffee machine. Relax in the comfort of the public lounge with its spacious patio or watch game come down to the waterhole at the main pool looking out over lush gardens and floodlit waterhole.

Activities include game drives and bush walks - Savanna Private Game Reserve is located in the Western sector of the Sabi Sand and guests are able to traverse approximately 9,000 hectares of beautiful bushveld. The area offers a diverse landscape from the open savannah grasslands up to the thick riverine bushveld.

Savanna safaris provide exceptional opportunities to see the Big 5 – lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino – as well as cheetah, wild dog, hippo, crocodile, an abundance of general game and over 400 bird species.



DAY SEVEN

Today you will transfer the 1 hour by road to Skukusa Airport in time for your flight to Cape Town. On arrival you will be met and transferred on a private basis to Cape Grace Hotel for 4 nights.



The Cape Grace Hotel is situated on a private quay between Cape Town's bustling V&A Waterfront and the tranquil yacht marina and there is no better position from where to soak in the natural beauty of the Mother City. With a choice of wonderfully luxurious rooms – some facing Table Mountain and others with a marina view – this is the perfect place to unwind and explore Cape Town from a convenient location in comfort and style.



DAY ELEVEN

Today you will transfer back to Cape Town International Airport in time for your international flight home.
