October is one of the very best times to visit the South Luangwa National Park and offers magnificent wildlife viewing. It is hot and dry and the water sources restricted to the rivers which in some areas are completely dry. Wildlife congregates around the few water resources and the action is never far away!

Join us on our Ladies Only Safari to the South Luangwa National Park in Zambia – we have just 4 places on this this outstanding safari staying at wonderful little camps in three very different areas of the park.

3RD OCTOBER 2020

On arrival into Lusaka you will be met and transferred to Latitude 15 Hotel for 1 night on a bed and breakfast basis.

Latitude 15° is set amidst the beautiful tree-lined avenues on the south-east corner of Lusaka and just 30 minutes from Kenneth Kaunda International Airport. With 32 spacious guest rooms and three 2-bedroom suites, a restaurant, bar, lounge and poolside terrace, blending modern Africa, with a cosmopolitan twist.



4TH OCTOBER 2020

Today you will be met at the hotel and transferred back to Lusaka International Airport in time for your flight to the South Luangwa National Park. On arrival you will be met by Robin Pope Safaris and transferred to Nkwali Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.



Nkwali is located on the banks of the Luangwa on a magnificent meander in the river overlooking the National Park where leopards roam along the bank and can often be spotted from camp. Situated on Robin Pope Safaris' private land outside the park there is a private game viewing area behind camp as well as exclusive access into the park either by boat or across the pontoon.

The six chalets with bamboo woven walls and thatch roofs offer a rustic luxury opening up to magnificent views of the river as well as open air en-suite bathrooms.

7TH OCTOBER 2020

Today you will be transferred by game drive to Tena Tena Camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis. Situated in the exclusive Nsefu Sector Tena Tena sits nestled under a magnificent and thick grove of mahogany trees. On a double tiered river bank each room enjoys its own private view onto a long stretch of the Luangwa River.



The six tents are very private with plenty of space between them and each with its own window onto a magnificent stretch of the Luangwa River where the hippos wallow and the lions roam. The en-suite bathrooms are spacious and open to the elements, designed to copy nature with curved walls around the trees and simple subtle colours and a view from every facility. Each tent is specifically located to maximize privacy both in the rooms, bathrooms and on the verandas with comfortable sitting areas and excellent views onto the river.

The main area moulded around a large termite mound and mahogany tree with an old hippo run adapted into our path between the different levels is shaded by an enormous tent strung up between leadwood poles. With plenty of different seating areas there is space to relax and unwind whilst reflecting on the day's safari, before sitting down to a beautiful dinner on the banks of the Luangwa, under the stars and enjoying the sounds of the African night.

10TH OCTOBER 2020

Today you will transfer to Nsefu Camp by game drive for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis. Situated in the exclusive Nsefu Sector on a magnificent meander on the Luangwa River across which elephants often cross lies the historic camp Nsefu.

The six original rondavels have been upgraded to include spacious en-suite bathrooms and each room has a clear view of the river whether it be from the comfort of your bed or the chairs out on the veranda.

From the dining room lunch can be enjoyed whilst watching large herds of elephants making their daily river crossing just upstream from camp. The bar and sitting area sit snugly between a large termite mound and lagoon, unobtrusive and cosy but making the most of the extensive wildlife that comes down to the lagoon to drink – lion and leopard can also be heard lapping away at the refreshing water in the evenings. What could be better than sitting in a comfy armchair enjoying a delicious slice of cake whilst watching anything from Antelope to Zebra coming down to drink.



13TH OCTOBER 2020

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip for your flight back to Lusaka in time to connect with your international flight back home.

Your safari includes: All meet and greets, road and air transfers, all accommodation, bed and breakfast in Lusaka and all meals whilst on safari, most drinks and laundry, all safari activities, park fees and tourism levy

Your safari excludes: International flights, extra meals in Lusaka, tipping, premium alcoholic drinks and any personal expenditure

You can extend your safari to take in more safari in the South Luangwa National Park or head to the North Luangwa for walking safaris, visit the Lower Zambezi National Park, the Kafue National Park or fly to Livingstone to see Victoria Falls in Zambia.

Alternatively extend to Malawi to enjoy some rest and relaxation on Lake Malawi, visit the tea estates and game parks in the south of the country or Nyika Plateaux in the north – please ask!
