


# LUXURY SMALL GROUP NORTHERN PANTANAL SAFARI 9 NIGHTS/ 10 DAY JAGUAR QUEST 4 – 6 GUESTS - £7,495 PER PERSON SHARING 21<sup>ST</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025 – 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025



Join our small group safari taking in the very best highlights of the northern Pantanal in central Brazil travelling with just 4 – 6 other guests on this outstanding itinerary with a focus on wildlife and birdlife.

Enjoy a once in a lifetime journey to the heart of the northern Pantanal – formerly an ancient inland sea and the largest seasonal floodplain on the planet. This journey spotlights the jaguar and we have dedicated 3 nights on a luxury floating hotel in the Porto Jofre area – known for its high concentration and ease of viewing this elusive and shy cat. With multiple sightings every day – this area is busy – but virtually guarantees lots of viewings! To break the long driving distances, we have also included 2 nights at Araras – a savanna ecolodge where you will have the chance of seeing different wildlife – crab eating foxes, armadillo, agouti, brown or grey brocket deer, giant anteater and tapir and if you are very lucky – ocelot, puma or jaguar!

Lastly you will head to the peaceful Paraguay River for 3 nights – close to the Taiama Ecological Reserve. Staying at a remote hotel set on the banks of the river - your wildlife viewing will be with only a few boats on the river each day, allowing you to relax and enjoy the wildlife and birdlife at a slower pace.

Wildlife of the area incudes capybaras, caimans, armadillos, giant anteater, crab eating wolf, marsh and brocket deer, the giant river otter and anaconda. Primates include Azaras's Capochin, black and gold howler monkey and the black tailed marmoset. In the evenings it is possible to see both the greater and lesser bulldog bat.

Birding at both river and savanna destinations is outstanding with over 580 species recorded in the Pantanal. Highlights include the boat billed heron, jabiru stork, hyacinth macaw, toco toucan, southern screamer, greater rhea, amazon kingfisher, great potoo, white woodpecker, capped heron and red legged seriema – amongst others!



## 21<sup>ST</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025 ARRIVE CUIABA – GATEWAY TO THE PANTANAL

On arrival into Cuiaba you are met and transferred to the Amazon Aeroporto Hotel set close to the international airport in Cuiaba for one night on a bed and breakfast basis – arrive any time today.

### 22<sup>ND</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025 PORTO JOFRE

After an early breakfast (you can pack your own if you prefer) you will meet your guide and fellow travellers and transfer 6 hours by road to Porto Jofre. On arrival into Porto Jofre, you will board a motorboat for a 15-minute transfer to the Jaguar Suites - an airconditioned floating hotel moored on the banks of the Piquiri River – arriving in time for lunch. After check-in you will be shown to your suite – home for the next three nights.

A little later after lunch and a siesta you will meet your guide and enjoy your first 4-hour afternoon boat safari in search of jaguar, giant river otters, caiman, capybara and a huge number of birds along the myriad of rivers and channels in the area.

Later in the evening as the sun is setting, return to the Jaguar Suites for dinner, an informative lecture on one of the species found in the Pantanal, and overnight.

#### **OVERNIGHT AT THE JAGUAR SUITES – FULL BOARD**

Your home for four nights will be a purpose-built, air-conditioned, floating hotel with WIFI, anchored in the middle of an area with the highest known concentration of jaguars with no commuting time – you are straight into the small boats directly from the floating hotel on the 100-meter-wide Piquiri River.

*Offering some of the best guest rooms in the Pantanal – the 12 spacious suites have four-meter-wide, floor-to-ceiling, sliding glass doors that face the wild forests of the famously-Jaguar-rich, 270,000-acre Meeting-of-the-Waters State Park.* 



### 23<sup>RD</sup> – 24<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025

You have two full days (in total five x four-hour river safaris) to explore the rivers and channels searching for wildlife and birdlife with lectures in the evening by the Floatel's naturalist. Each day you will rise early and enjoy a hot breakfast before heading out on the river for 4 hours before returning to the floating suites in time for a buffet lunch. After free time in the early afternoon head off again for another 4 hours on the water, returning to your hotel as the sun sets in time for dinner, evening lecture and overnight.

### **OVERNIGHT AT THE JAGUAR SUITES – FULL BOARD**

### 25<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025

This morning you will rise early and enjoy breakfast before heading out for a short water safari. Make your way to meet the vehicle and drive back along the Transpantaneira Road for around 4 hours before reaching Araras Lodge, arriving in time for a buffet lunch.

In the afternoon enjoy a jeep safari within the grounds of the lodge, enjoying the huge diversity of birds, mammals and reptiles. Your drive will go on into the early evening and a spotlight should produce nocturnal wildlife with the

chance to see ocelot, puma, giant ant eaters, the southern tamandua, the Brazilian rabbit, armadillo, crab eating foxes and possibly, if you are lucky, maned wolf or jaguar. Drive back to the lodge where you will enjoy a buffet dinner and overnight.

#### **OVERNIGHT AT ARARAS LODGE ON A FULL BOARD BASIS**

Set inside the sprawling Pantanal wildlife sanctuary, this laid-back eco lodge is set around 3 km from the main Transpanteria Road and 30 km from Poconé. The lodge has a large dining room and bar, outside seating patios, a covered outdoor dining room and a swimming pool set in gardens. Walking trails lead from the main lodge to the surrounding countryside and the lodge has two observation towers.

Featuring private entrances and screened windows, the air-conditioned guest rooms provide en-suite bathrooms, plus porches with hammocks, overlooking the swimming pool, gardens and ponds surrounding the lodge. Activities such as guided safaris, horseback rides, birdwatching, canoeing and hiking are available at the lodge.



### 26<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025

A whole day to discover the savanna areas around the lodge – you can enjoy a morning horse riding, some more birding, discover one of the many walking the trails with a guide, or enjoy a land safari in a specially converted 4 x 4 vehicle. Or simply relax in your hammock with a good book or enjoy a cool off in the lodge's swimming pool set in wonderful gardens filled with birds.

#### **OVERNIGHT AT ARARAS LODGE ON A FULL BOARD BASIS**

#### 27<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025

Rising early, enjoy a hearty breakfast before departing for Hotel Baiazinha – around 5 hours driving through scenic countryside. You will drive on the Transpantaneira Road towards Pocone and on to Caceres before continuing a further 62 miles on dirt roads through stunning landscape dotted with cattle ranches and farmland, before finally arriving at your last lodge on our Pantanal journey. Hotel Baiazinha is set on the banks of the Paraguay River close to the Taiama Ecological Reserve.

This is a wonderful location to spend your last three days exploring the Paraguay River, coming back to the lodge for meals and overnight. The lodge is set in a remote area and the exploring is peaceful – you might just well be the only boat on the river apart from local fishermen. Your days are filled with boat safaris along the river in search of jaguars, caimans, capybara and giant river otters and if you do find a jaguar – you are likely to be the only boat to enjoy the sighting. The birdlife is astounding with regular sightings of kingfishers, cormorants, anhinga, ibis, spoonbills, teals, herons, bitterns, egrets, storks, skimmers, terns, lapwings, plovers, vultures and herons. **OVERNIGHT AT HOTEL BAIAZINHA ON A FULL BOARD BASIS** 

The hotel offers a complete contrast to the busy Porte Jofre area – it has a small private jetty where your boat safaris start and finish, and the hotel is built around a central paved area with a swimming pool and the dining room serving breakfast overlooks the river.

The airconditioned, ensuite rooms are set around the central area, simply furnished but comfortable, and there is a table and chairs for each room outside in the corridor. The main restaurant serves a buffet dinner in the evening, made from locally sourced ingredients. Free WIFI is available. Apart from river safaris, you can enjoy horse riding and river fishing.



## 28<sup>TH</sup> AND 29<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025


Two full days enjoying two x four-hour boat safaris per day exploring the river systems in search of birdlife and wildlife. In your free time in-between lunch and your river safaris you can enjoy a dip in the lodge's swimming pool or a siesta.

#### 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER 2025

This morning you will enjoy an early breakfast, departing early from the lodge and driving back to Cuiaba, arriving at the airport around midday. You can either check into your international flight home, enjoy a night in Cuiaba or explore more of Brazil – please ask!
