DAY ONE – KLEINS CAMP

On arrival into Kilimanjaro International Airport, you are met and transferred to Arusha airport in time for your light aircraft flight to Kleins Camp in the northeastern Serengeti. On arrival at Lobo Airstrip, you are met and transferred to camp for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

Escape the crowds on this private concession with access to the Serengeti. This strategic wildlife sanctuary borders the Serengeti - with wildlife moving freely through these areas and with only &Beyond vehicles on sightings and sensitive offroad driving, you can get closer to the wildlife. This wildlife-rich corner of the Serengeti is famous for its enormous prides of lion, as well as some of the best leopard viewing in Tanzania. Enjoy both walking safaris and night drives too!

The camp is intertwined with the local Maasai communities who lease the land to the camp offering you the chance to get to know the Masai Culture and interact with Maasai people working at the lodge daily. You will also have the opportunity to visit a Massai boma not far from the camp, and learn about the day-to-day activities, responsibilities and culture of this tribe.

Perched on the edge of the Kuka Hills, ten comfortably furnished cottages with whitewashed walls and rich wooden floors overlook the valleys below. The stone interiors of the guest areas have breathtaking panoramas, and deep leather armchairs invite you to relax during siesta time. The camp has a spa and a stunning pool with views over the concession.



DAY FOUR – GRUMETI SERENGETI RIVER CAMP

Today you will transfer back to Lobo Airstrip in time for your light aircraft flight to the Grumeti area of the Serengeti. On arrival you will be met and transferred to camp for 4 nights on an all-inclusive basis. Located in the remote western reaches of the Serengeti National Park, expect a private Serengeti safari experience complete with resident hippo pods and remarkable lion prides.

The lodge is situated on the banks of a tributary of the Grumeti River and is beautifully decorated with an emphasis on the circular forms of a traditional Maasai manyatta, Kitenge fabrics, and the vibrant colours of the fishing communities surrounding Lake Victoria. Spacious decks are perfect for enjoying sundowners overlooking the river, and the lodge's sparkling rim-flow swimming pool provides a view of the seasonal hippo pods below and wildlife on the opposite bank.

There are just 10 elegant and very spacious guest suites offering natural light, an enormous bed, indoor bath shower with views, and a private plunge pool.

This part of the Serengeti is known for its big lion prides consisting of between 20 and up to 60 lions. Not only are the opportunities for seeing lion in the western Serengeti excellent, but you will more often than not find yourself alone at a sighting. Twice-daily game drives from the lodge often encounter large lion prides, clans of hyena, big herds of resident plains game, as well as black-and-white colobus monkeys.

During June every year you have the chance of viewing the migration as it heads northwards – but the wildlife viewing is superb at any time of the year and during the quieter months you may have the whole landscape to yourself!



DAY EIGHT – MNEMBA ISLAND ZANZIBAR

Today you will transfer back to the airstrip in time for your flight to Zanzibar. On arrival you will be met and transferred to the north east of the island to be met by the Mnemba Island boat which will take you across to the island in just 5 – 10 minutes!

Welcome to a place where shoes are left at the door and the world with them. Here, time is kept by the tide. Mornings begin with fresh tropical breakfasts delivered to your Banda. The sea invites you to snorkel, swim or simply be still. Evenings unfold beneath the stars, with sushi, stories and the sound of waves as your soundtrack.

There is something amazing about this little island - just 12 luxurious, open-air Bandas, including a family banda, rest beneath whispering casuarina trees. No doors and no windows, only soft sand between you and the sea. Time drifts with the tides and the ocean becomes your lullaby. In front of your banda is your private seaside haven - complete with a day bed, sun loungers and an al fresco shower. Enjoy light island fare and cocktails with uninterrupted ocean views.

Snorkel the House Reef or dive into the vibrant marine world that surrounds the island. Watch green turtles nest, swim with wild dolphins, walk the reef at low tide, or greet the sunrise with yoga in the trees. Visit the spa, enjoy a sand flat picnic, glide across the ocean on a traditional dhow as the sky melts from pink to indigo. Or do nothing at all. A wonderful way to end your Tanzanian experience!
