This region brings together deep wetlands and dry forests, creating a vibrant natural corridor where animals gather in massive numbers. Wildlife highlights include huge herds of elephants and buffalo moving along the rivers, alongside giraffes, zebras, and water-adapted red lechwe. Tracking these movements are the area's top carnivores: resident lion prides, leopards using the tree canopies for cover, spotted hyenas, and wide-ranging packs of endangered wild dogs.

The Chobe River and Okavango waterways reveal an entirely different ecosystem. Exploring the channels by boat brings you face-to-face with pods of hippos interacting in the deep pools and if lucky, you may see the highly elusive sitatunga—an unusual antelope with splayed hooves designed specifically for walking

across unstable, floating vegetation. The constant interplay between wet marshes and dry savanna keeps the wildlife dynamic and moving throughout the day.

For birdwatchers, there is a huge variety of avi flora to enjoy. The air is filled with the calls of fish eagles and the quick movements of bright kingfishers diving for prey. This habitat is highly regarded for species that are incredibly difficult to find anywhere else - the large, nocturnal Pel's fishing owl roosting in overhanging branches, tall, wattled cranes wading the shallows, and African skimmers gliding just inches above the water's surface.

ITINERARY

DAYS 1 TO 3

Welcome to Botswana! You are met at Kasane International Airport and transferred to your first camp - &Beyond Chobe Under Canvas for 3 nights on an all-inclusive basis.

&Beyond Chobe Under Canvas is pitched deep within Chobe National Park, moving between private wilderness sites every few weeks, keeping you close to the northern Chobe Riverfront—an area famous for supporting massive wildlife populations.

The camp offers a traditional, back-to-basics safari experience with just five classic Meru-style canvas tents hosting a maximum of ten guests. Operating entirely off-the-grid without mains electricity or Wi-Fi, it allows you to fully unplug and listen to the sounds of the African night. Each walk-in tent features comfortable beds, solar lighting, and an ensuite bathroom where the crew fills a traditional bucket shower with hot water upon request. Dining is a social affair; wholesome meals are cooked directly over an open campfire and served under the stars or inside a shared canvas mess tent.

The main draw is the sheer volume of wildlife, particularly the elephant herds, lions, leopards, and buffalo that roam through the unfenced camp grounds. You will head out on twice-daily game drives in open vehicles and enjoy water-based safaris. You can board motorboats on the Chobe River to drift past pods of hippos, sunbathing crocodiles, and herds of elephants swimming across the channels. Evenings finish with a sunset drink by the riverbank before returning to camp to sit around the crackling fire.

3 NIGHTS AT &BEYOND CHOBE UNDER CANVAS



DAYS 4 AND 5

Today you will transfer to Kasane Airport in time for your light aircraft scenic flight to &Beyond Sandibe Under Canvas.

&Beyond Sandibe Under Canvas is located within the Okavango Delta and sits on a private 22,500-hectare concession just south of the Moremi Game Reserve. This area is made up of open grassy plains, acacia trees, and woodlands. The camp is small and intimate, featuring just three insect-proof canvas tents that host a maximum of six guests at any one time. It is designed to capture the atmosphere of a classic 1920s mobile safari, prioritizing a low-impact environmental footprint without sacrificing basic comforts.

Each tent is built on a raised wooden platform and includes a private veranda, a proper flushing toilet, running hot water, and standing fans to cool the tents. Despite its remote, off-the-grid solar operation, the camp still provides Wi-Fi in the guest rooms. Meals are cooked over an open campfire and enjoyed in a shared canvas dining tent or under the night sky.

One of the main highlights of the camp is its location within one of the predator-rich areas of the Delta, providing chances to spot lions, leopards, cheetahs, and African wild dogs. Because it is on a private concession, guides are permitted to drive off-road to track wildlife and operate night drives to spot nocturnal animals. The daily schedule focuses on twice-daily 4x4 game drives with a guaranteed window seat for every guest, alongside guided bush walks that offer a closer look at the local flora and fauna.

2 NIGHTS AT &BEYOND SANDIBE UNDER CANVAS ON AN ALL-INCLUSIVE BASIS



DAYS 6 AND 7

Today you will transfer to the airstrip in time for your light aircraft scenic flight to &Beyond Nxabega Under Canvas.

&Beyond Nxabega Under Canvas is positioned in the western sector of the Okavango Delta and the camp sits beside a seasonal floodplain on a private 25,000-hectare concession that shares a boundary with the Moremi Game Reserve. This setting provides a mixture of permanent water channels, seasonally flooded grasslands, and small islands covered in jackalberry and palm trees.

The camp focuses on simple, expedition-style living with just three fully netted canvas tents, meaning a maximum of six guests are on site at any given time. It offers a modern take on the classic 1920s mobile safari, meaning it values a light footprint over heavy, permanent structures. Each tent is pitched on a raised wooden deck and comes equipped with proper beds, a private veranda, a flushing toilet, and a gas-heated shower. The camp relies on solar power and incorporates modern additions like in-room charging points and Starlink Wi-Fi. Guests gather around a central open-air fire pit and a shared canvas mess tent for home-style platters prepared over the campfire.

A key feature of this location is the balance between land and water adventures, allowing you to experience two distinct sides of the Delta. In addition to morning and night 4x4 game drives to look for predators and the "Big Five", the camp provides water-based excursions when seasonal levels permit. You can explore the quiet channels in a mokoro—a traditional wooden dugout canoe pushed by a poler—or try catch-and-release fishing for local species. Guided bush walks are also available to study the birds and track wildlife on foot.
